DAP leaders won't commit to Dr M's big reveal

GEORGE TOWN: Penang DAP has refused to commit on whether they will accept the deputy prime minister's position if the opposition comes to power in the next general election.

DAP national vice-chairman Chow Kon Yeow declined to comment, while its secretary-general, Lim Guan Eng, said he did not want to answer questions from the *New Straits Times*.

The party's deputy secretary-general, Dr P. Ramasamy, said the party had not considered asking for or

even accepting the deputy prime minister's position.

When questioned further, Ramasamy said it was not appropriate for him to comment on the matter.

On Wednesday, Parti Pribumi Bersatu Malaysia chairman Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad was quoted as saying that DAP had asked for the deputy prime minister's post if the opposition came to power.

On Thursday, however, Lim denied that the party had made such a request.
