# 'Pakatan top 3 leaders can't work together'

**PUTRAJAYA:** Parti Bersatu Rakyat Sabah (PBRS) president Tan Sri Joseph Kurup does not believe that Pakatan Harapan opposition pact's top three leaders can cooperate with one another.

Kurup said, for instance, the history between former prime minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad and PKR de facto leader Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim would make it difficult for them to be on the same page concerning issues.

"We know that according to history, they cannot even make eye contact with each other. So how can they work together as a team?"

"For me, it is difficult to understand how they can be in the coalition. I wonder if they can lead the pact.

"Can they develop the coalition? I don't think the three can serve the party well," Kurup said after the Sunsuria City Eco Charity Bicycle Ride event in Sepang.

He was commenting on Pakatan Harapan's new leadership line-up.

Kurup, who is also minister in the Prime Minister's Department, said PBRS was not disturbed by the pact's latest line-up.

"I am confident that Barisan Nasional will retain Sabah in the next general election. However, we cannot take things for granted.

"We need to work hard."
