Najib's visit a pleasant surprise for trader

PUTRAJAYA: A coffee trader was pleasantly surprised when Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak stopped to buy a cup of coffee from his food truck here.

The operator, who is based in Central Market, was excited with Najib's purchase that he immediately shared photos of the prime minister's visit on his Facebook page, KPcopies, with the caption "I love PM".

According to the Facebook posting, Najib had visited the food truck that served authentic "kampung" coffee at the Felda carnival held in conjunction with Felda Settlers Day.

Najib came at 5pm, and officials from the Prime Minister's Office said the leader would be making more surprise visits at the carnival to be closer to the people.

Felda Settlers Day started yesterday and is expected to attract more than 50,000 people.
