Opposition fought to unseat him when he was in power, says NGO founder

**I**T is absurd to name Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad as the next prime minister if the opposition wins the next general election.

Youth Solidarity Malaysia founder Badrul Hisham Shaharin said the opposition fought to unseat Tun Dr Mahathir when he was prime minister.

"It is insane for the opposition

to appoint a dictator like Tun Mahathir as the next prime minister," said Badrul Hisham, who is known as Chegubard, yesterday.
