Najib announces solution for overcrowded village school in Telok Panglima Garang

PRIME Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak yesterday brought cheer to villagers in Telok Panglima Garang here, where he announced several initiatives to improve their quality of life.

Speaking during the "Iftar with Rakyat Selangor" programme, Najib said the gov-

ernment would solve the overcrowded conditions at SK Kebun Baharu, which catered to 2,000 children from two nearby villages.

"I have agreed to the construction of a new school here, or additional blocks at the existing school," he said, adding that the Federal Government would also allocate funds to repair the Nurul Iman mosque here.

Najib earlier visited the homes of Ahmad Selamad, 75, and taxi driver Faizah Md Ambiah, where he gave contributions to

refurbish their dilapidated homes.

After speaking at the Nurul Iman mosque, Najib handed out contributions to orphans and *asnaf* (eligible recipients). He also announced a RM1.6 million allocation for the Kuala Langat Fishermen's Association.

Najib later performed the isyak and tarawih prayers, before giving contributions to the Single Mothers' Association, welfare homes and Government Pensioners' Association.
