PUTRAJAYA: Malaysians play an important role in safeguarding the country against militancy and extremism, said Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak.

The best form of control against militant beliefs and extremist ideologies came from the people themselves, Najib said at the Hari Raya Aidilfitri open house of the prime minister and ministers here.

“If the people continue to be stern and not be influenced, we can celebrate festivals such as Hari Raya today (Sunday) in peace and harmony, free from fear.

“This is what we must defend and safeguard for the sake of the people,” he said in a live interview with a local television station.

“The country’s security and prosperity can be compromised if the people fall prey to these ideologies,” Najib said, adding that maintaining security should not only be the responsibility of security forces, but all Malaysians, too.

He praised the security forces for ensuring the country’s peace

and security.

“Today, we enjoy a peaceful environment and well-maintained security.

“We feel secure, for example, with the good security control at today’s (Sunday’s) event.

“It shows that peace in the country is guaranteed without any undesirable incidents.”

Najib said unity was important for Malaysians as it was the foundation for political stability and confidence among all parties.
