PM pleased with Rahim's role in Thai peace talks

BANGKOK: Prime Minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad said he is satisfied with the role played by former inspector-general of police Tan Sri Abdul Rahim Noor in the peace talks to end the violence in southern Thailand.

He said the peace talks between Mara Patani, representing the many factions, and the Thai government, were proceeding well, but added that it would take time to resolve the issues.

“Finding a solution is not easy

because the conflict involves many factions.

“We have to seek the views of all factions besides knowing their interests,” he said after receiving an honorary doctorate degree in social leadership, business and politics from Rangsit University here.

Rahim was appointed the facilitator of the southern Thailand peace process on Aug 25, taking over from Datuk Seri Ahmad Zamzamin Hashim. **Bernama**
