made before we came into power," Dr Mahathir said at the Inaugural Dr Mahathir Mohamad Leadership Series of the Malaysian Institute of Management here yesterday.

"We made promises thinking that we would lose.

"It was meant for the government in power and if it won, they it have found it difficult to fulfil

the promises."

"Fortunately, or unfortunately, we won and now we have to boost our efforts to do so.
