ANNUAL CONSULTATION

Malaysia, Indonesia set for more talks

KUALA LUMPUR: Malaysia and Indonesia will further discuss bilateral matters and other issues of common interest during the 13th Malaysia-Indonesia Annual Consultation to be hosted by Indonesia.

The Foreign Ministry said in a statement among the issues were the Asean car project, cooperation in the oil palm industry, community learning centre, mar-

itime boundary delimitation, land boundary demarcation, Indonesian domestic workers and the Indonesian flight information region.

“During Indonesian President Joko Widodo’s visit to Malaysia on Thursday and Friday, Prime Minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad and the Indonesian leader discussed the issues briefly. They also touched on Timor-

Leste’s application to join Asean,” it said.

The date for the annual consultation has yet to be decided.

The statement said Dr Mahathir also extended an invitation to Joko, better known as Jokowi, to attend the KL Summit to be held from Dec 19 to 21.

It said the meeting reflected the commitment to further strengthen bilateral relations. **Bernama**
