Muhyiddin: Najib fears being 'cut out' of Umno

SEMENYIH: Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak is making an endless appearance in Semenyih because he does not want to be "cut out" of Umno by deputy president Datuk Seri Mohamad Hasan, claims Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin.

The Parti Pribumi Bersatu Malaysia president claimed that there was an internal split in Umno and the former prime minister was trying to retain power.

"Do you know why he keeps coming here?"

"It is because he sees Mat Hasan (Mohamad) has risen to power.

"I bet there are people who are telling him (Najib) that he must go out or people will forget him.

"He sees that Umno president (Datuk Seri Dr Ahmad Zahid Hamidi) is out of the picture and if Mat Hasan takes over, he will lose any opportunity to come back," he said in a programme at Kampung Baru Semenyih.

Muhyiddin said Najib planned to make a comeback like Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad but believed the people would reject him.

"He comes taking selfies, he comes shopping bringing a trolley, but do not forget he is the real number one culprit," he said.

Speaking to reporters later, Muhyiddin said he observed that after Barisan Nasional won in Cameron Highlands, Najib came to Semenyih quite regularly.

"He thinks that if he does not come out, he will fade, people will forget him.
