

# Dr M: MACC needs time to probe RM90m allegation

**KLANG:** Prime Minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad said yesterday the Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission (MACC) needs time to investigate the allegation that PAS received RM90 million in 1Malaysia Development Bhd (1MDB) funds.

He said MACC may not have obtained all the details in relation to the case.

"The MACC statement that there is so far no trace of RM90 million entering the official accounts of PAS from 1MDB may be because the MACC has yet to obtain the full details ... it (the investigation) will take time," he told a press conference after opening Metrod Holdings Bhd's plant here.

Mahathir also said MACC is still looking into more allegations against former prime minister Datuk Seri Najib Abdul Razak and needed time to investigate.

When asked about his remarks that he did not understand the attitude of PAS which was constantly changing despite the party expressing support for him to stay on as prime minister, Mahathir said he did not really need PAS support as he already had the support of Pakatan Harapan MPs who made up the majority in Dewan Rakyat.

"I don't need support from PAS because PH already control half the seats in Dewan Rakyat. And the supports are from those who had won the election, not those who were about to lose and still struggling to win.

"If PAS wants to support me, they can do so, but don't go telling me that a pledge of support has been signed but not for PH, only for me. I'm not the government, PH is," he said. - Bernama
