PM opens new Parliament library

KUALA LUMPUR: Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin has opened the new Parliament library after it was moved to the Members of Parliament and administrative block, which was completed in January.

Previously, the library was located in the Parliament complex main block.

The library has a collection of 43,114 original documents, such as the Straits Settlements and the Federated Malay States Legislature,

Official Statement of the Dewan Negara and Dewan Rakyat, Standing Orders, Bills, Acts, Statute Papers, Order Papers, Committee Reports, Enactments, Ordinances and Government Gazettes.

The centre also has a collection of monographs, journals and newspaper clippings.

The library is an important reference source on matters about legal, Parliament as well as government and public administrations to

support the need for research by MPs and others in Parliament towards lifelong learning.

Earlier, Muhyiddin spent some time touring and officiating the parliamentary exhibition – Citra Perundangan Malaysia (Image of Malaysian Law), which showcases illustrations of Parliament to introduce the importance and sovereignty of the legal institution.

The exhibition is open until Sept 18.
