

# PM proud many taking heed of strict S.O.P rules

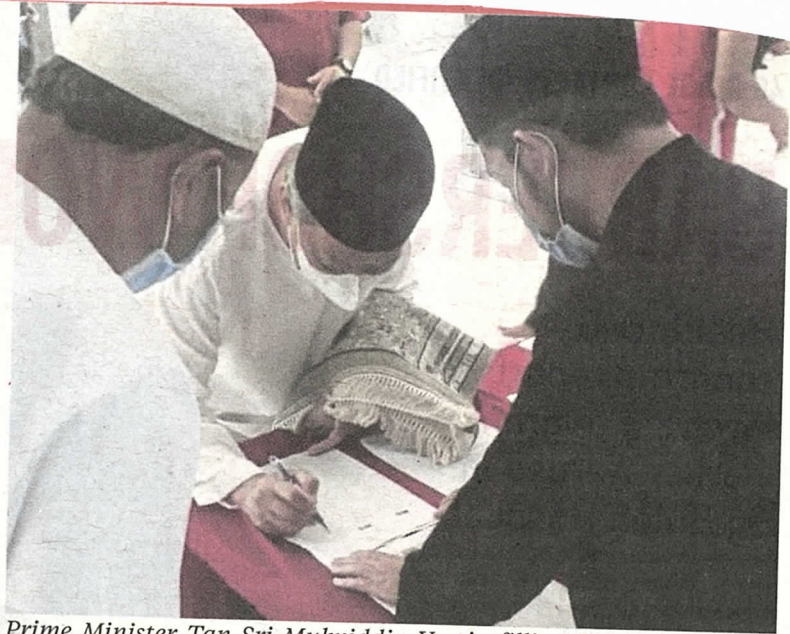

**KUALA LUMPUR:** Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin yesterday expressed pride at the level of compliance with the standard operating procedure by Malaysians for Friday prayers.

He said his observation while joining the congregation to perform Friday prayers at Saidina Umar Al-Khattab Mosque in Bukit Damansara here yesterday showed the public giving their full cooperation in queuing up and having their temperature checked before entering the mosque.
