KUALA LUMPUR: "I did not feel a thing," said Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin after receiving his first dose of the Pfizer-BioNTech Covid-19 inoculation yesterday.

Speaking to reporters after being placed under observation, Muhyiddin said he was confident the vaccine was safe and effective.

"If you look at me now (I am feeling well), *Alhamdulillah*. I did not feel a thing.

"The injection was over very

quickly and felt like any other injection.

"Don't worry, come forward (and get vaccinated)," he said.

He urged Malaysians to register for the vaccination on the MySejahtera application and wait for their turn to be immunised.

"I believe in the government's efforts to ensure that we can break the Covid-19 chain."

He will receive the second dose in 21 days on March 17.
