

# PM on two-day working visit to Sabah

**KOTA KINABALU:** Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin will be in Sabah today for a two-day working visit - his first to the state since Gabungan Rakyat Sabah (GRS) took over the state administration after the September state polls.

Among the main events during the Prime Minister's visit are to launch the Lok Kawi Resort City development project and witness the foreign/domestic investment initiative's memorandum of understanding signing at Sabah International Convention Centre (SICC).

Muhyiddin will arrive here in the evening and start his two-day visit with a gathering with community

leaders at a downtown hotel.

Tomorrow, he will attend a "Makmur Bersama Sabah 2030" town hall session at the Sabah administrative centre building in the morning before proceeding to visit the Kota Kinabalu district Covid-19 vaccination centre nearby.

The Prime Minister is also scheduled to pay a courtesy call on Yang di-Pertua Negeri Tun Juhar Mahiruddin at Istana Negeri.

After the programme at SICC, Muhyiddin will visit two houses at Tanjung Aru for charitable purposes before flying back to Kuala Lumpur.
