

# PM ARRIVES IN JAKARTA FOR 3-DAY VISIT

Schedule includes meetings with Jokowi, Indonesian media and Malaysian diaspora

## JAKARTA

**P**RIME Minister Datuk Seri Ismail Sabri Yaakob arrived here yesterday for a three-day official visit to Indonesia, at the invitation of Indonesian President Joko Widodo.

Ismail Sabri arrived at the Halim Perdanakusuma International Airport here in a government jet at 10.10am, accompanied by Finance Minister Tengku Datuk Seri Zafrul Tengku Abdul Aziz.

They were greeted by Indonesia's Education, Culture, Research and Technology Minister Nadiem Anwar Makarim and Foreign Minister Datuk Saifuddin Abdullah, who had arrived earlier.

Present were Charge d'affaires of the Malaysian Embassy in Indonesia Adlan Mohd Shaffieq and Indonesia's Foreign Affairs Ministry Director for Protocol Irvan Bukhari.

The prime minister and the Malaysian delegation will put up at the Ritz-Carlton Jakarta, at Mega Kuningan in the capital's central business district.

This will be Ismail Sabri's first

visit to the neighbouring country since being sworn in as the country's ninth prime minister on Aug 21.

Ismail Sabri's schedule includes meetings with Joko, also known as Jokowi, the Indonesian

business community, chief editors of Indonesian media and the Malaysian diaspora here.

The prime minister is also expected to witness the signing of Memoranda of Understanding and Agreement between the two

countries and pay a visit to a defence industry facility in Bandung.

This visit is held in accordance with the Covid-19 standard operating procedures set by both governments. **Bernama**
