

MINISTERS' EVALUATIONS TO BE MADE PUBLIC

Public perception among elements used to measure 100-day performance, says PM

PUBLIC perception of cabinet members, their ministries and departments is among three elements used to evaluate the first 100-day performance of ministers under the leadership of Prime Minister Datuk Seri Ismail Sabri Yaakob.

The performance of ministers within 100 days after assuming their positions will also be measured according to their leadership skills that will be evaluated based on the outcome of initiatives implemented by their respective ministries or departments.

Ismail Sabri in a statement yesterday said the other main element in the performance evaluation of cabinet members include the performance of the ministers and ministries.

"Each cabinet member has

been instructed to make public their 100 Days Keluarga Malaysia Aspiration Achievement Report Card.

"This is to enable the people to evaluate their performance for the wellbeing of Keluarga Malaysia.

"The government fixed such a performance aspiration (target) as the highest priority for each cabinet member to ensure they provide the best services to the people."

Ismail Sabri said he conducted a meeting with his ministers on Sept 24 and Sept 29 to finalise the proposed performance aspiration (target) for each of them.

"The implementation of the initiatives for each of the aspirations is based on six main cores, which include re-structur-

ing the economy, ensuring the safety and order of the nation as well as elevating the social wellbeing of the people.

"Other main cores in the implementation of the initiatives include comprehensive increasing of the infrastructure,

strengthening unity in the spirit of Keluarga Malaysia and empowering delivery services," he said.

The Chief Secretary to the Government's office, the Malaysian Administrative Modernisation and Planning Unit (Mampu) and the Shared Prosperity Delivery Unit (Sepadu) have been appointed the joint coordinators of these

initiatives.

Ismail Sabri said this was to ensure that all planning, implementation as well as improvement for the performance aspirations outlined in the spirit of Keluarga Malaysia by all cabinet members could meet its target in an excellent manner.
