We're thinking about easing 3 SOP rules, says Ismail Sabri

SEREMBAN: The government is thinking about easing three standard operating procedures (SOP) to curb the spread of Covid-19, which will be announced soon, said Prime Minister Datuk Seri Ismail Sabri Yaakob.

The three involved the wearing of face masks, MySejahtera check-in when entering premises and Covid-19 tests, he added.

He said the matter was being evaluated by the Health Ministry.

"We will announce this soon. Good news, so after easing them the restrictions), people will be happy, he added.

"Maybe we will look at the wearing of face masks.

"The Health Ministry will evaluate and weigh their pros and cons.

"For the requirement for MySejahtera check-in on premises and whether the RTK or PCR test is required at airport (departures), all these are being deliberated by the Health Ministry."

He said this after visiting a welfare home here yesterday.

Health Minister Khairy Jamaluddin on Friday reported that more SOP would be eased in the coming weeks.
