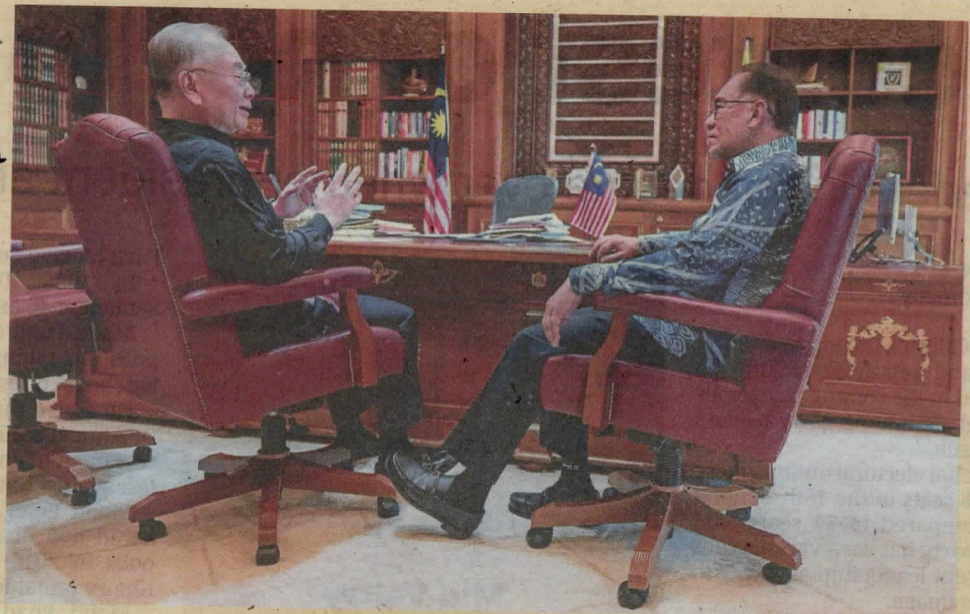
"I took the opportunity to convey
