Nine M'sians, two dependents return home from Ukraine

SEPANG: Nine Malaysians with two dependents who were evacuated from Kyiv, Ukraine have safely returned to the country yesterday.

The group, including Charge d'Affaires ad interim Fadhilah Daud, arrived at KL International Airport (KLIA) at about 3.06pm

via Qatar Airways flight QR0848.

The group was taken to Poland on Feb 27, after Russian President Vladimir Putin announced on Thursday a special military operation in Donbas, east Ukraine. Following the announcement, Ukraine President Volodymyr Zelenskyy declared an emergency

in the country.

Ukraine also closed the air space for civil use due to the high risk posed to civil aviation.

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Ismail Sabri Yaakob and Foreign Minister Datuk Seri Saifuddin Abdullah were present at KLIA to meet the returnees. - Bernama
