Anwar, Erdogan exchange Raya greetings

PUTRAJAYA: Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim on Monday received a phone call from Turkiye President Recep Tayyip Erdogan.

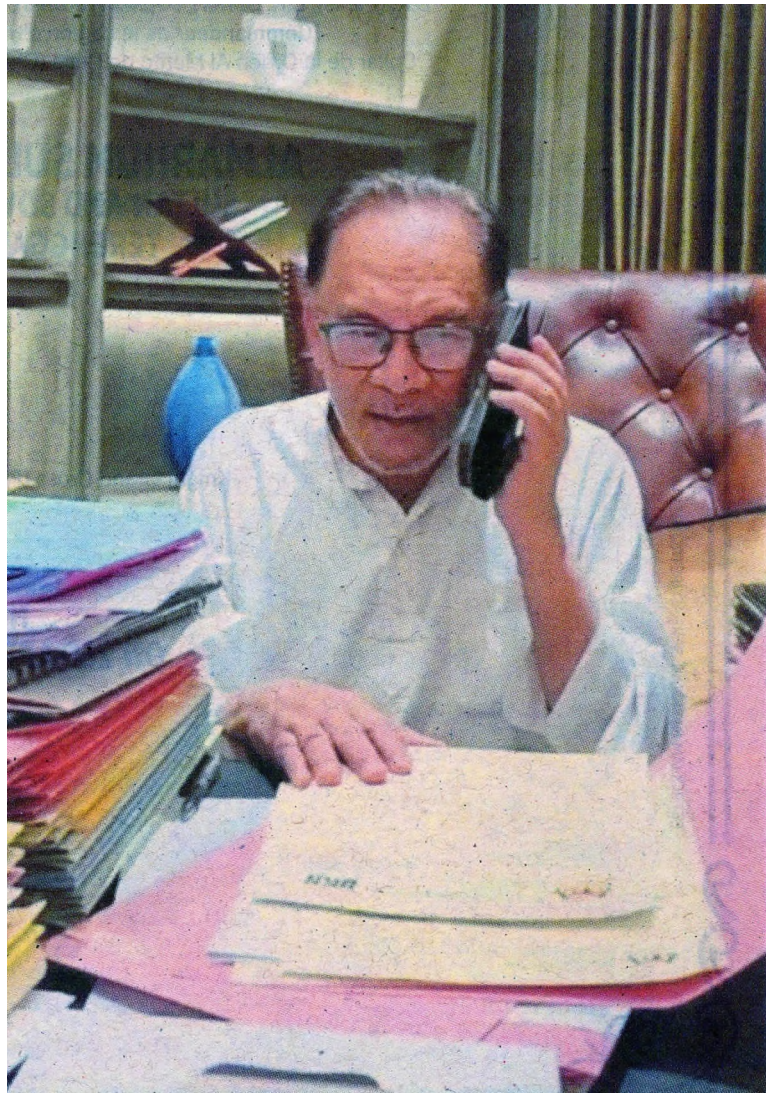
The two leaders exchanged Hari Raya Aidilfitri greetings while discussing bilateral relations.
