PM makes contributions to 2 victims kin

KUALA LUMPUR: Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim has extended his personal contribution to the next of kin of two victims of the aircraft crash in Bandar Elmina, Shah Alam, last week.

In a Facebook posting yesterday, Anwar said the contributions were delivered through his political secretary, Ahmad Farhan Fauzi, on Friday when the latter visited the family of the late Idris Abdol Talib @ Ramali, in Kampung Ketari, Bentong.

Idris was the special officer to Pelangai assemblyman Datuk Seri Johari Harun, who also died in the incident.

Anwar said Farhan also visited and delivered contributions to the family of the late Khairil Azwan Jamaluddin in Felda Mempaga 1, Karak.

“I share their sorrow and pray that the families are given strength and fortitude to weather this challenge.”

On Aug 17, 10 people died when a private jet traveling from Langkawi to Subang crashed in Elmina.

The victims comprised six passengers and two pilots. Also killed were two members of the public, both e-hailing and p-hailing drivers, who were on the road when the aircraft crashed.
