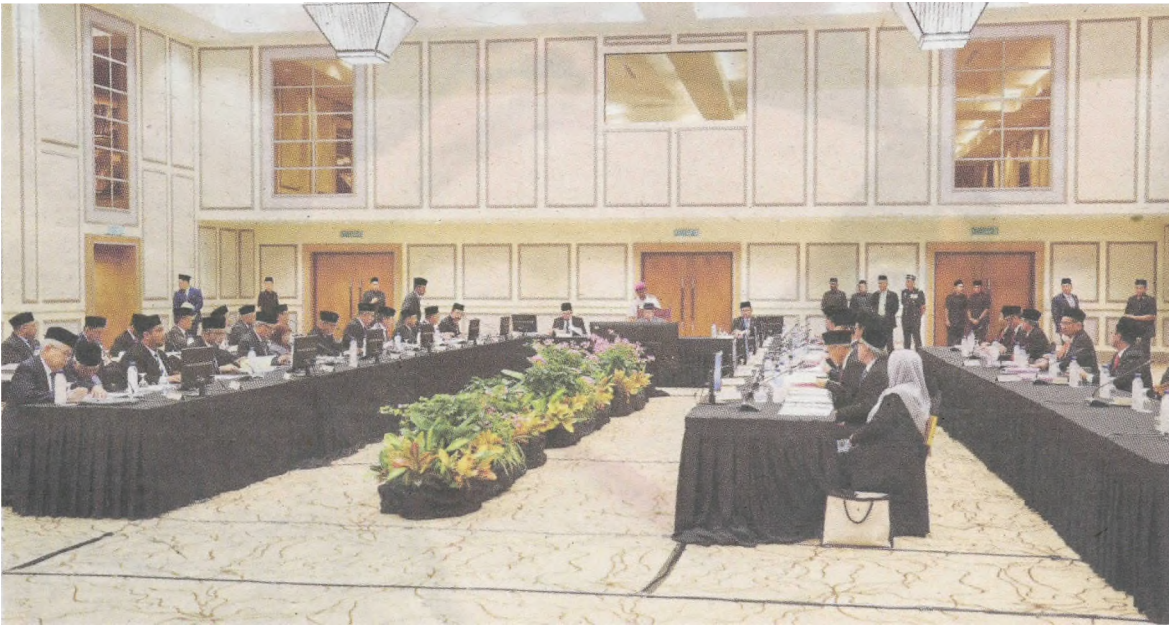


PM MAKES ISLAMIC GOVERNANCE VOW
