

# Govt on solid ground says PM

**KUALA LUMPUR:** Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim said the desperate *tebuk atap* (political manoeuvring to orchestrate the government's collapse) attempts by the Opposition will not succeed because the unity government, helmed by 18 component parties, has *bumbung yang konkrit* (solid support).

Anwar added that throughout the one year of leading the government, never once had they (parties) been at loggerheads due to each party's policy differences.

"*Bumbung kita bumbung konkrit* (our roof is made of concrete). In Putrajaya now, there is no more political manoeuvring.

"There have been attempts, some said August. But I think we have our strengths. Not once have I been at loggerheads with Cabinet ministers due to party differences. Everyone has different opinions," he said at a dialogue session during the closing ceremony of the *Madani* government's one year anniversary programme yesterday.
