Terengganu MB, exco rapped for failing to host PM

KUALA LUMPUR: Terengganu Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Dr Ahmad Samsuri Mokhtar and his executive councillors have been criticised following their failure to host Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim during his Jan 2 visit to the state.

Mat Ali said the act was rude and disrespectful. “The absence of the menteri besar and his exco members looks as if they’re belittling the presence of the prime minister in Terengganu,” he wrote on Facebook.

He said the excuse of not being informed officially by the Prime Minister’s Office was baseless.
