

PM to address queries on maritime treaties with Indonesia in Dewan

PUTRAJAYA: Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim will answer questions regarding maritime treaties with Indonesia in the Dewan Rakyat today.

Responding to Perikatan Nasional (PN) chairman Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin, who had asked why the treaties involving

the Sulawesi Sea and Straits of Malacca were signed, Anwar said he would address the matter during the Prime Minister's Question Time.

"I'll answer it in Parliament tomorrow.

"He better be there (to listen to the answer)," Anwar said at Per-

dana Putra here yesterday.

Present was Economy Minister Rafizi Ramli.

At a PN rally in Negri Sembilan on Saturday ahead of the state polls, Muhyiddin had questioned whether the signing of the treaties on the delimitation of territorial seas would mean

Malaysia was compromising on matters of national sovereignty and international borders.

The treaties were among six bilateral instruments signed during Indonesian president Joko Widodo's working visit to Malaysia last Thursday.
