

## COLLAPSE OF GOVT CLAIM

# 'It's Hadi's right to plan and be delusional'

**SERDANG:** Pas president Tan Sri Abdul Hadi Awang is delirious in claiming that the unity government would collapse soon, said Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim.

"It's okay, it's his right to plan and be delusional," said Anwar after performing Friday prayers' at the Universiti Putra Malaysia mosque here yesterday.

He said this when asked to respond to Hadi's prediction that the unity government led by Anwar would collapse.

In a dialogue event with a book publisher recently, Hadi had predicted the fall of Anwar's government, but did not explain how

it would happen.

He made the statement not long after he told the parliament that the unity government's collapse would not be the opposition's fault.

Meanwhile, Anwar said that RM50 million would be distributed immediately to aid Johor's flood victims.

He added that he would make a visit to Johor soon.

"RM50 million will be distributed immediately to help the flood victims in Johor.

"Some ministers have already gone down to Johor, and another

group of ministers will also go there tomorrow (today).

"I will arrange a visit to Johor as soon as possible," he said.

On Thursday deputy prime minister Datuk Seri Dr Ahmad Zahid Hamidi had said that as much as RM10 million would be allocated by the federal government to buy materials and essential aid for the flood victims in Johor.

He said that the allocations were to meet the needs of all flood-affected districts, and would be increased if insufficient.
