

Najib takes aim at Muhyiddin on Facebook

KUALA LUMPUR: Tit for tat.

Perhaps that was the essence of jailed former prime minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak's terse posting on Facebook yesterday — believed to have been authored by an administrator — to Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin in relation to the latter's graft charges.

"Kita tengok pula jika dia dikerumun lepas ini (Let us see if people will gather around him after this)," the posting read.

The posting included a screenshot of a news item titled *"Orang kerumun Najib sebab nak tengok 'perompak' lebih dekat, kata Muhyiddin"* (People are gathering around Najib to

take a closer look at a 'robber', Muhyiddin said).

Up to the time of publishing, the posting has 8,000 likes and 1,100 comments.

Najib is serving a 12-year jail sentence after he was found guilty of all seven charges related to the misappropriation of RM42 million of SRC International funds.

On Friday, Muhyiddin was charged with six counts of corruption and abuse of power involving RM427.5 million.

He pleaded not guilty to the six counts before Sessions Court judge Azura Alwi.

Muhyiddin is out on a RM2 million bail.
