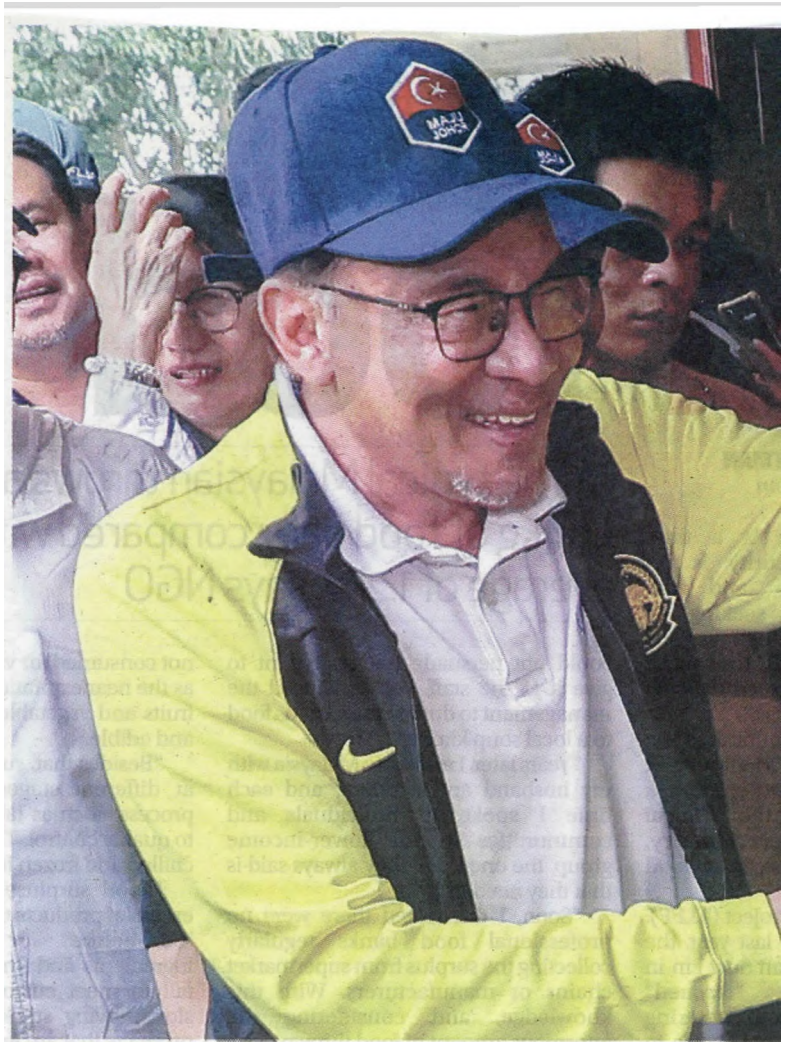

## Anwar visits relief centre in Segamat

**SEGAMAT:** Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim yesterday visited flood evacuees housed at the Sekolah Kebangsaan Gemerah temporary relief centre here.

He spent around 20 minutes with them at the relief centre that was providing shelter to 125 people from 32 families.

Anwar also inspected the educational psychological activity room for children at the centre, which is run by the Social Welfare Department.

His arrival was warmly welcomed by the evacuees, including the elderly and young people, who were happy to meet with the country's leader personally.

Earlier, Anwar was given a briefing on the flood situation in the district at the 4th Royal Artillery Regiment, Segamat Camp.

Next, he visited evacuees housed at the Sekolah Jenis Kebangsaan Cina (SJKC) Kampung Tengah relief centre that was accommodating 502 people from 133 families.
