PUTRAJAYA: Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim yesterday said the health of his deputy, Datuk Seri Dr Ahmad Zahid Hamidi, has improved and he will soon resume his duties.

Anwar said he had visited Zahid before officiating the Karnival Usahawan Desa under the Rural and Regional Development Ministry at Anjung Floria.
