

# PM expresses commitment to send food, medicine to Gaza

**KUALA LUMPUR:** Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim has expressed Malaysia's commitment to deliver food and medicine to alleviate the sufferings of those affected by the violence in Palestine.

He also called for a ceasefire and for Israel to pursue a peaceful resolution and leave their politics of dispossession to end all violence.

He also called for the establishment of a humanitarian corridor in Rafah.

"I had a phone conversation

with Hamas' political bureau head Ismail Haniyeh yesterday (Monday) to express Malaysia's unwavering support for the Palestinian people.

"Given the dire situation in Gaza, I strongly advocate for the immediate cessation of bombardment and the establishment of a humanitarian corridor in Rafah," he said in a Facebook post.

He said it was crucial and paramount to prioritise the wellbeing and safety of all individuals affected by the crisis.
