KUALA LUMPUR: The international community should urgently insist on stopping the massacre of people in Gaza, said Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim.

He said the matter was conveyed

to Turkish President Recep Tayyip Erdogan when they discussed various regional and international issues, including the current situation in Palestine through a phone call.

"I stated that the international

community must urgently insist the massacre and elimination of the people of Gaza be stopped.

"Malaysia will continue to be committed in voicing the country's firm stance on the plight of the

Palestinian people on the world stage," he said in a post on his Facebook page yesterday.

Anwar said Erdogan also expressed hope to intensify the relationship between the two

countries, especially in the fields of trade and defence.

He invited Erdogan to visit Malaysia, and both leaders also exchanged *Hari Raya Aidilfitri* greetings. – Bernama
