

# 'Take action against Muhyiddin for playing up 3R issues'

**KUANTAN:** Umno vice-president Datuk Seri Wan Rosdy Wan Ismail yesterday urged the authorities to take action against Perikatan Nasional chairman Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin for touching on 3R (race, religion and royalty) issues during the Nenggiri state seat by-election campaign.

The Pahang menteri besar said he was upset by Muhyiddin's speech.

"I am upset and offended by Muhyiddin's speech, which he made while campaigning in Nenggiri.

"This interferes with the authority of Sultan of Pahang Al-Sultan Abdullah Ri'ayatuddin Al-Mustafa Billah Shah when he served as 16th Yang di-Pertuan Agong."

Wan Rosdy said: "As a former prime minister, Muhyiddin should not drag the palace institution into his campaign to get votes by spreading misinformation about the 15th General Election.

"I believe the people agree with the authority of His Majesty (Al-Sultan Abdullah), who succeeded in putting a stop to the country's political turmoil by forming a unity government, where Pas and Bersatu had rejected his decree," he posted on Facebook.

Wan Rosdy called on the authorities to take action against Muhyiddin for creating disharmony by touching on 3R issues.

This would serve as a lesson and reminder to all quarters, he said.

"I hope people continue to respect the royal institution, which is a symbol of sovereignty, unity and protection."

It is believed that he was referring to Muhyiddin's speech, where he claimed that he had the backing of 115 members of parliament in the 2022 general election, and that the king should have called him to be sworn in as prime minister.
