

EX-PM's LATEST ACCUSATION

Take care of your health, Anwar advises Dr M

KUALA LUMPUR: Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim yesterday refused to entertain the latest outburst by former prime minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad, who accused the former of being an expert in political manoeuvring and forming backdoor governments.

The prime minister instead advised Dr Mahathir to take care of

his health.

"Tidak apalah (it is okay). Please look after your health," Anwar briefly told reporters after the launch of a two-day discourse to formulate a higher education strategy here yesterday.

Earlier yesterday, Dr Mahathir, in a posting on his Facebook page, denied any involvement in the alleged "Dubai Move" in the

United Arab Emirates, involving opposition leaders and several government representatives, to replace the unity government.

The former Langkawi member of parliament accused Anwar of being an expert in political manoeuvring and forming backdoor governments, citing an incident on Sept 16, 2008 and the "Kajang Move" in 2014.
