

Sanusi apologises to Anwar

Interests of the people should precede political power, he says

JITRA: Datuk Seri Muhammad Sanusi Md Nor (pic) has apologised to Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim and Cabinet ministers for making inappropriate remarks that could jeopardise the *hablumminnas* (relationship with other humans) aspect.

The Kedah Menteri Besar sought forgiveness from Anwar and ministers who were attending an
