

PKR PRESIDENT'S TERM

Anwar can serve as PM even after GE16, says Fahmi

CYBERJAYA: There is no issue about Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim serving as prime minister despite nearing the end of his term as PKR president.

PKR information chief Fahmi Fadzil said yesterday this was be-

cause Anwar still held the Pakatan Harapan (PH) and unity government's Leadership Council chairman position, which allowed him to serve as prime minister even after the 16th General Election.

“PKR does have a three-term limit for the president’s position, but at this time, there is no issue.

“Anwar can continue serving as prime minister now and even the next term,” said Fahmi after launching the National Courier Day here.

Present were his deputy Teo Nie Ching and ministry secretary-general Datuk Mohamad Fauzi Md Isa.

Anwar has held the position of PH chairman since 2020.

On Nov 7, PKR secretary-general Datuk Fuziah Salleh said Anwar would continue as PKR pres-

ident during the party’s election, expected to take place next year.

This came after questions arose about whether the term after the upcoming election would be Anwar’s last as PKR president, a role he has held since 2018, and his position in the government.

On Oct 27, Anwar called for the PKR election to be expedited.

He said speeding up the party election would create opportunities for collaboration between younger members and veteran leaders, allowing them to work together to manage the party.
