## Anwar, Yoon hold talks on M'sia-South Korea ties

**SEOUL:** Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim met South Korean President Yoon Suk Yeol at the Yongsan Presidential Office yesterday.

The two leaders, accompanied by several ministers; held a bilateral meeting for about an hour, where they touched on the achievements and progress made since both countries established diplomatic ties 64 years ago, and the

future direction to be taken.

Malaysian Ambassador to South Korea Datuk Mohd Zamruni Khalid said the leaders took stock of Malaysia-South Korea bilateral ties that have significantly progressed in scope and substance since the establishment of diplomatic ties in 1960, Bernama reported.

"They also discussed regional and international issues of mutual concern,

and exchanged views on Malaysia's chairmanship of Asean and South Korea's chairmanship of Apec, both in 2025."

Anwar was accompanied by Foreign Minister Datuk Seri Mohamad Hasan, Investment, Trade and Industry Minister Datuk Seri Tengku Zafrul Tengku Aziz, Science, Technology and Innovation Minister Chang Lih Kang and National Unity Minister Datuk Aaron Ago Dagang.
