

# PM: LOOK TO PROPHET AS THE GREATEST TEACHER

**M**alaysians must emulate the nobility of Prophet Muhammad, not only in character but also in leadership and societal unity, said Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim.

In a Facebook post about Maulidur Rasul, Anwar called on the nation to view the Prophet as the greatest example in guiding personal, communal and national life.

"As the world faces a drought of moral leadership, we must continue to look to Prophet Muhammad as the greatest teacher of humanity, as our supreme role model."

He said the Prophet's leadership, especially in the Madinah Charter, serves as a model for building a diverse yet united society grounded in justice and benevolence.

"The aspiration for a Madani nation draws from the principles of the Madinah Charter, which

Prophet Muhammad pioneered."

Citing the Quran, Anwar reflected on the timeless relevance of the Prophet's example.

"In *Surah Al-Ahzab*, verse 21, Allah says: 'Indeed, in the Messenger of Allah, you have an excellent example for whoever has hope in Allah and the Last Day and remembers Allah often.'"

Maulidur Rasul marks the birth of Prophet Muhammad.

Anwar earlier attended the national-level Maulidur Rasul 1446H celebration held at the Putrajaya International Convention Centre, yesterday.

Gracing the event were His Majesty Sultan Ibrahim, King of Malaysia, and Her Majesty Queen Raja Zarith Sofiah.

Also in attendance at the event, themed "Al-Falah: The Catalyst for Malaysia Madani", were the prime minister's wife Datuk Seri Dr Wan Azizah Wan Ismail, Minister in the Prime Minister's Department (Religious Affairs) Datuk Dr Mohd Na'im Mokhtar, and senior civil servants.

The event, held by the Department of Islamic Development Malaysia, was attended by 6,000 people from 131 contingents.
