PM to deliver address today ahead of National Day celebration

KUALA LUMPUR: Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim will deliver a special address today to inspire unity and patriotism ahead of the National Day celebration.

The event at the Malaysia Agro Exposition Park Serdang is expected to be attended by more than 4,000 people, comprising civil servants, uniformed personnel, educators, students, youths, union representatives, as well as entrepreneurs, cooperatives and small traders.

Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Ahmad Zahid Hamidi, Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Fadillah Yusof, National Unity Minister Datuk Aaron Ago Dagan and Selangor Menteri Besar
