MOSQUE DEDICATED TO LATE PRINCE

PM updates king on current developments

The mosque is being built using funds bequeathed by the king's late son, Tunku Abdul Jalil Sultan Ibrahim, the Tunku Laksamana of Johor, who passed away on Dec 5, 2015.

It will be able to accommodate nearly 1,000 worshippers at a time.
