# Let PKR decide, says Anwar

**KUALA SELANGOR:** Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim said yesterday he will not interfere in PKR's top leadership decision to leave its top two positions uncontested.

In response to speculation that the PKR president and deputy president positions may remain uncontested, Anwar, who is party president, said the decision lied entirely with party members.

"Let them decide. I am not interfering (in the decision). Let democracy take its course," he said after the groundbreaking of the Residensi Rakyat Programme in Bestari Jaya.

It was reported that the PKR president and deputy positions will remain uncontested in the party polls in May. The move aims to maintain the status quo, ensuring Anwar and Datuk Seri Rafizi Ramli retain their positions as president and deputy president, respectively.

Anwar's senior political secretary, Datuk Seri Shamsul Iskandar Md Akin, said discussions were underway to avoid a contest for the top positions.

PKR's elections for Leadership Council, Women's Leadership Council, and Youth Leadership Council are on May 24.
