ISMAIL SABRI STABLE AFTER COLLAPSE

Ex-PM rushed to hospital after falling unconscious at his home at 2.30am

FORMER prime minister Datuk Seri Ismail Sabri Yaakob was rushed to the hospital after falling unconscious at his home yesterday.

The Bera member of parliament, 65, was taken to Sunway Medical Centre in Kota Damansara at 2.30am.

His press secretary, Azran Fitri Rahim, confirmed the matter and said Ismail Sabri was in stable condition.

"I was informed that Datuk Seri collapsed at home and was taken

to the hospital about 2.30am for treatment."

He urged people to pray for Ismail Sabri's health.

Leaders from both sides of the political divide offered well wishes and prayed for Ismail Sabri's recovery.

On Facebook, former prime minister and former Umno president Datuk Seri Najib Razak said: "Let us all pray for his recovery as soon as possible."

Pahang Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Wan Rosdy Wan Ismail, who is Umno vice-president, said: "I received news that my friend, Datuk Seri Ismail Sabri Yaakob, Bera member of parliament and former prime minister, has been admitted to Sunway Medical Centre in Kota Damansara after

Ismail Sabri was the ninth prime minister, serving from August 2021 to

November 2022.

He was an Umno vice-president from 2018 to 2023. He has been Bera PM since 2004.

Hailing from Temerloh, Pahang, he began his political career as a Temerloh Umno committee member in 1987 and has held various party positions, with the last being vice-president.
