

# Govt approves RM10 million for Muar projects

**MUAR:** The federal government has approved an allocation of RM10 million for development projects in this district.

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim said the funds would be disbursed immediately to ensure that Muar residents could enjoy better well-being and a stronger economy.

“The government wants the people of Muar to enjoy balanced development. This RM10 million allocation will be utilised effectively through various identified

development projects,” he said at the launch of the 2025 National Month and Fly the Jalur Gemilang Campaign at Tanjung Emas here yesterday.

Present were Communications Minister Datuk Fahmi Fadzil and Menteri Besar Datuk Onn Hafiz Ghazi.

After launching the event, Anwar also flagged off the 2025 Merdeka Jalur Gemilang Convoy, involving 88 land vehicles, 66 vessels and more than 300 participants.

The convoy will carry the Jalur Gemilang through 88 checkpoints across the country: 44 in the peninsula, 20 in Sabah, 22 in Sarawak and two in the Federal Territory of Labuan.

It will end at Dataran Putrajaya on Aug 31, the venue for the 2025 National Day celebration.
