

Truce struck

Following recent border tensions, Thailand and Cambodia have agreed to an immediate and unconditional ceasefire during a special meeting facilitated by Malaysian Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim. Geopolitical experts, however, say more needs to be done to ensure long-term harmony.
