

# Anwar tight-lipped following stepping down of minister

**PETALING JAYA:** Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim has remained tight-lipped following the resignation of Datuk Ewon Benedick as Entrepreneur and Cooperatives Development minister.

Anwar who is on a two-day working visit to Sabah, offered only a brief indication that he would comment in due course.

"I will, I will...", he reportedly told reporters after the Rancakkan Madani

Sabah event at the Sabah International Convention Centre, without elaborating further.

Ewon announced his decision to step down in a post on his Facebook page.

His decision was reportedly made on principle, particularly concerning Sabah's 40% revenue entitlement under the Malaysia Agreement 1963 (MA63) and the Federal Constitution.
