PM to attend rally for Palestinians

KUALA LUMPUR: Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim has issued a clarion call for Malaysians to show solidarity with Palestinians at a gathering in Bukit Jalil today.

The prime minister invited all Malaysians to attend the “Himpunan Solidariti Bersama Gaza: Gelombang Malaysia, Palestin Merdeka” at Axiata Arena.

The gathering, also billed as the “Himpunan Solidariti Flotilla Sumud Nusantara”, will feature the recently-released Malaysian volunteers of the Global Sumud Flotilla, who will be in attendance.

“Come, let us unite as one nation, voicing solidarity for the

struggle of the Palestinian people, together with the heroes and heroines who have just returned after being detained during the Global Sumud Flotilla humanitarian mission.

“I am confident and believe that, in the heartbeat of every Malaysian, there is a firm resolve to continue fighting for justice and universal peace.

“Let us join hands and move in unison, raising our voices for a free, dignified, and sovereign Palestine. See you tomorrow night,” he said in a social media post.

Anwar is scheduled to attend the event which starts at 8pm.
