# Muhyiddin reaffirms foie as Bersatu leader and PN partner

**KUALA LUMPUR:** Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin has told Bersatu members that he remains the party's leader.

In his New Year's message to party members, Muhyiddin also said Bersatu remained part of Perikatan Nasional.

"I wish to stress that I continue to lead Bersatu as president.

"Although I no longer head PN, Bersatu remains a loyal partner within PN, and this cooperation will continue to be upheld for the sake of the coalition's stability and strength.

"I call on all Bersatu members to strengthen cooperation, reinforce unity and seal any cracks in the party," he said in a Facebook post yesterday.

Muhyiddin said that in facing the current challenges, the priority was to ensure Bersatu's continuity, strength and future.

"Sometimes, we need to take a step back, which is not a sign of weakness, but a strategic move to strengthen our foundations, reorganise the leadership ranks' and build a more structured and sustainable party," he said.

The former prime minister urged all Bersatu members to remain steadfast and disciplined, uphold a culture of mutual respect, and resolve any differences maturely.

Muhyiddin, who led PN for five years, resigned as the coalition chairman on Tuesday.
