

# Dr M: No peace with newer weapons

**KUALA LUMPUR, Fri.** — Western countries are always inventing newer and more sophisticated weaponry to resolve conflicts, former Prime Minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad said.

“They still think that killing people can eliminate their problems.”

He said these politicians allocated a lot of funds for the invention of more efficient weaponry mainly to kill

people.

“But despite having precision bombs, they somehow manage to miss the soldiers and hit the civilians instead.”

Dr Mahathir said this after receiving the “Rotary Award for Outstanding Visionary Leadership and Contribution to World Peace” from Rotary International president Bhichai Rattakul tonight.

He said the world needed

Rotarians who cared about humanity, more than politicians who were more concerned about creating weapons of mass destruction.

“The Rotary movement must not be confined to its services to the people but should educate the people on humanitarian values.

“If everyone was a Rotarian, the world would be a more peaceful place.”
