Opposition has no issues, says Dr M

LANGKAWI, Sun. — Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad said the Barisan Nasional is facing the general election in a better atmosphere compared with the 1999 polls, as the Opposition has no issues to harp on.

“There are no (real) issues for the Opposition except for those which Pas and DAP have created themselves.

“We, on the other hand, have

done all that we should have,” he said here today after launching the Langkawi Waterfall, which is the highest man-made waterfall in the country.

The former Prime Minister said this when asked how he compared the 1999 general election and the coming polls on March 21.

Dr Mahathir, who is now Kedah BN

adviser, was also asked on his advice to election candidates in the State who are not selected.

“Everyone must accept the decisions made about the selection of candidates,” he said.

On the island’s voters, Dr Mahathir said Langkawi residents should also not question the choice of candidates.
