

**GSTT Teachers To Start Training In Dec – Muhyiddin

KUALA LUMPUR, Aug 2 (Bernama) -- Some 972 untrained attachment teachers (GSTT) will undergo 18 months training at public institutions of higher learning in December.

Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin said another 2,821 GSST teachers would be trained at teacher training institutions (IPG) for January 2012 intake.

"These teachers who are eligible for reappointment under "contract of service" are among 7,258 GSST teachers yet to be appointed.

"For those attending the course at IPG, degree holders will train for 18 months while non-graduates will undergo 66 months training under the Bachelor's Degree in Education Programme," he said in a statement here Tuesday.

Muhyiddin who is also Education Minister said the position of the remaining 3,465 GSST teachers would be determined after they met the conditions.

He said some of them still have the opportunity for reappointment or selected for teacher training after a review is completed.

"For those not reappointed, a review of their record will be done and confirmation will be made by month's end."

Posting will be to meet and support implementation of new policies like Kurikulum Standard Sekolah Rendah (KSSR) and Penilaian Berasaskan Sekolah (PBS).
